Teddy Bear's Picnic

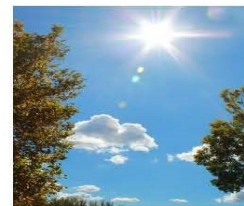
at St. Thomas' Anglican Church Family Service
