Message from Canon Greg Jenks

PENTECOST SUNDAY

This Sunday we bring the Great Fifty Days of Easter to their climax, as we celebrate the continuing presence of Jesus—the Risen Lord—in our midst as the divine Spirit. This is much more than the so-called "birthday of the church," as it is often described. This is about celebrating the deep meaning of Easter: Jesus is alive, Jesus is with God as we also shall be after our death, and Jesus is always with us as Spirit.

In 1 Corinthians 15, Paul wrote about this profound mystery that is at the very heart of our faith:

"The first man, Adam, became a living being"; the last Adam became a life-giving spirit. But it is not the spiritual that is first, but the physical, and then the spiritual. The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man isa from heaven. As was the man of dust, so are those who are of the dust; and as is the man of heaven, so are those who are of heaven. Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we will also bear the image of the man of heaven." (Vss 45–49)

Our worship at the 8.30am service this Sunday will be a mix old and new, as the Choir joins us to offer the gift of their music ministry and the children stay with us throughout the liturgy as we celebrate one of the principal feasts of the Church Year. May you know the joy of our Lord's presence and the spiritual power of the Spirit of Jesus within us. Alleluia.


